Our ambition in Sustainability will be supported by:

- Zero waste to landfill by 2030, increase recycled waste ratio in 2022 to 75% in all of our activities
- Enforcing our global sourcing for renewable energies above 85% (e.g. solar panels, electric/hybrid company cars)

- Striving for ZERO fatalities of our own staff, contractors and 3rd parties
- Continuing the successful NO HARM campaign with a rollout of a Level 3 training for (operational) management
- Increased recording of positive observations and unsafe act / unsafe condition within the HSE-app
- Reduction of Group LTIF with minimum of 10%

We achieve our targets in Security by:

- Enhance supply chain security by meeting ISO 28001 and Authorised Economic Operator (AEO) standards
- Expanding the KN SecureChain network above 65 strategic sites globally to ensure cargo security
- Support the EU Safe&Secure Parking Places Standard to enhance the working conditions of drivers and reduce the risk of thefts
- Continuously train all personnel in security awareness
